

Attention All October 13th 1pm-5pm Jazz-in-the-Yard Concert Goers:
In case you need 'em, here are directions to the Jackson Homestead and Museum
527 Washington St. Newton, MA 02458

The Jackson Homestead and Museum is located at the corner of Washington Street and Jackson Road, between Newton Corner and Newtonville. **The concert will be on the back yard lawn.**

♣ From the East/Boston: Take Exit 17 off the Mass. Pike to Washington Street, following the signs for West Newton. The Museum is on the right, one-third of a mile west of the exit.

♣ From the West/Mass. Pike: Take Exit 17, loop left around the Crowne Plaza Hotel onto Washington Street, and proceed west. The Museum is on the right, one-third of a mile west of the exit.

♣ From North or South off Route 128 (I-95): Take Exit 21/21A to Route 16 East. Go east on Route 16 to West Newton. Keeping in the right lane, cross over the Mass. Pike. Keeping right, go through the West Newton business district and follow Washington Street (parallel to the Mass. Pike) about two miles. The museum will be on the left just beyond the set of lights at Adams Street.

♣ Public Transportation

Bus routes 57, 504, 553, 554, 556, and 558 all stop within walking distance of the museum. The Framingham/Worcester Commuter Rail Line's Newtonville stop is also within walking distance. For more information, please go to the MBTA website www.mbt.com
